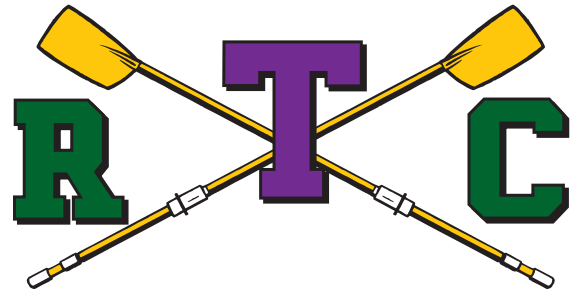

Guidelines for Use of Facilities

at Maclay State Gardens

Agreement Period 2007-2008



1. Park rules, regulations and instructions are provided for the safety and enjoyment of all visitors that use the facilities and must be obeyed.
2. Drive safely - obey posted speed limit and stop signs. Tickets may be issued by Park Law Enforcement officers for infractions.
3. All vehicles must be parked in a designated parking space, not in medians or on road shoulders. No parking by posts separating parking lot from main pavilion lawn.
4. Parking spaces between the boat ramp and the main picnic pavilion on the lake side of the parking lot are to be reserved for use by paying park visitors. They are not to be used by crew team members, coaches, or parents coming to pick up rowers.
5. An identification pass will be prominently displayed in all crew vehicles. The park entrance fee will be charged for any vehicle that does not have a pass.
6. Land activities must be supervised by a responsible adult who must be easily identifiable by park staff.
7. Tables will not be moved from the picnic pavilions.
8. All trash must be placed in the dumpster.
9. Running will be confined to the recreation area parking lot. Other land exercise will be conducted near the storage buildings.
10. Unobstructed access for park visitors must be maintained in the parking lots, picnic pavilions, restrooms, boat ramp and swimming area.
11. When loading and unloading boats, the roadway must not be obstructed at any time. Boat trailers will not be left in the parking lot upon return from regattas.
12. Clothing, shoes, books, backpacks, etc. will not be placed on park signs, tables, in picnic pavilions, on pavement or other park facilities.
13. Profanity is not to be used in the park.
14. Please be considerate of other park visitors who come here for an experience of peace and serenity.
15. Football and other games may be played in the grass behind the main pavilion, not in parking lots, on roadways or areas adjacent to or in the gardens.
16. The safety boat will not intentionally create any unnecessary wake.
17. Swimming will be in the designated swimming area only.

Thank you for assisting the staff at Maclay State Gardens in our effort to provide clean and safe facilities for the use and enjoyment of the public. We hope these guidelines will allow continuation of a beneficial and cooperative relationship. Remember, infractions are cumulative and could result in the suspension of your privileges to use the facilities. Feel free to ask for clarification related to these guidelines from your coach or park management.
